




Problem / Opportunity Statement

To address existing and future needs for Main Street Markham to enhance community character, support commercial activities, respect and protect heritage, social and environmental features, and address transportation needs within the study area.





Alternatives Development

- The range of alternatives were developed to build on the "status quo" or do nothing alternative.
- All alternatives will include a range of streetscape and urban design components to compliment the areas.










ALTERNATIVE E - TYPICAL SECTIONS





ALTERNATIVE F-TYPICAL SECTIONS




