

# **Growth Forecasts Analysis**

- Staff is preparing a database to support analysis for growth forecasts
- Supply Analysis: potential to accommodate units, population, employment, intensification opportunities and criteria, by location within the current settlement area
- Demand Analysis: requirements to accommodate population, employment and housing growth, reflecting demographic and market changes, and Town growth objectives
- Whitebelt: based on accommodation potential within the current settlement area, and forecast demands, potential need/opportunities for additional greenfield development

### Town Forecasts Database

#### Database estimates include:

- □ dwelling units by type
- population
- employment
- □ intensification opportunities

## Data organization:

- □ 5 year intervals 2006 to 2031 and 2031+
- permits comparison to Regional zone forecasts

## **Town Forecasts Database**

- Town Forecasts Database will contribute to:
  - □ Growth analysis and options (eg. 40%, 60% intensification); determining consistency with senior government policies
  - ☐ Market assessments
  - □ Commentary to Region of York, Province
  - □ Transportation, servicing, municipal soft services studies
  - □ Development charges reviews, financial analyses
  - □ Identification of Whitebelt options
- Forecasts Database targeted for Q1 2008
