Board Education

The PANAM Torch Relay is coming to Markham on June 27th. There is a detailed plan of all activities that will be published soon. The Museum is opening the Perfect Match, the Science of Sport that same day. We are working with PANAM organizers to have flags available at the Museum for visitors to welcome the torch. There will be limited amount of flags, but those that have one, will be admitted to the Museum to see the exhibition for free that day.

Directors Report

At the meeting of Council last evening, both the Operating and Capital budgets were passed. Highlights of Capital work for 2015, beyond the usual upkeep and maintenance of the building and collection are:

I Mountjoy washrooms are almost complete due to pre-approval of funds to meet Museum schedules. Other work to be done in Mountjoy in 2015 includes, new windows on all above grade rooms, brick-work repairs, replacement of fire escape, and other minor repairs.

In New HVAC in Transportation Hall

I Kinnee Barn, new cladding, new flooring, raccoon proofing and re-programming

In Museum Strategic Plan

Strickler Barn feasibility study

Operating, as reported earlier, has resulted in a \$50,000 cut to the Museum subsidy and further \$50,000 in 2016.

The Museum is very pleased with the appointment of Moe Hosseini-Ara as Culture Director. The City is investing in a Culture Department, and a leader that is capable of redefining the department so that we will be better placed for future growth and development, and cultural awareness in the community.

The Museum is in preliminary discussions with a local business man who would like to bring master potters from China to display their tea pots, with an accompanying tea tasting area. The Museum has space available in the Mezzanine in September, and that time is good for the group. This activity meshes well with our program direction, particularly with our pottery component. One of the Chinese masters has requested clay from the Rouge clay bed, in order to make a Markham pot. I am actively trying to find a way to source the clay.
