Board Education

Negotiations to bring a tea pot exhibition from China to the Museum in September have been completed. The exhibition will be here for Applefest and will feature associated tea tasting and perhaps members of the Chinese opera.

Director's Report

The Torch Relay event on June 27th will pass the Museum about 11 am. Panam is supplying the Museum with 100 flags to hand out to members of the public to cheer on the torch. After the torch has passed, flag holders will receive free admission to the Science of Sport exhibition. The Museum Director continues to attend the Ontario Museum Association meetings as a member of the "Looking Ahead: Realizing the Full Potential of Ontario's Museums task force. This is an exciting project to be a part of. It consists of 12 Museum professionals from across all across the province.

Exhibitions:

- a) The Honey House art installation will open in July
- b) Science of Sport opens June 27th
- c) Keva has re-opened in the Mezzanine to complement camp and summer programs

Capital Projects:

- a) Site lighting will be installed this summer
- b) Kinney Barn will be re-roofed over next few weeks
- c) Mount Joy School original windows have all been repaired. New storm windows were installed this week. The fire escape will be installed later this month
- d) The Collection building hallway roof is leaking. Dan is working with a consultant to determine what the problem is. The roof is flat and is designed to hold water to cool the building.

Programs:

- a) Pottery programs are selling better than expected. Anticipating a two year ramp up to full programs, we are pleased to report that some classes are already selling out. Other classes are also selling well.
- b) Museum summer camps are sold out, with the exception of three senior camps that have a couple of spots.
