Staff recommends that in accordance with By-Law 4-2000 which reads:

".. that the Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to award any required contracts greater than \$350,000 for the annual Council summer break between the last meeting in June or July, as the case may be, and the next regular Council meeting which are in compliance with the City's Purchasing By-law and which are within budget as approved by Council;"

BACKGROUND

The City issued a bid for qualified contractors to supply of all labour, vehicles and equipment necessary to undertake the Woodlot Ash Tree Removal Program. The trees to be removed are owned by the City and are within City maintained Woodlots and Parks. The majority of the Work will involve tree climbing in areas that are isolated, remote, and away from vehicles. Some areas involved are accessible only through private properties

Note: The bid document was issued with the following understanding:

There will be two (2) contractors awarded the work and each contractor must have a minimum of one crew available for the contract term. The lowest bidder will be awarded 60% of the work ($434,011.49 \times 0.60 = 260,406.89$) and the second lowest bidder will be awarded 40% of the work ($460,158.72 \times 0.40 = 184,063.49$).

Some of the trees have deteriorated very rapidly and the work needs to be addressed quickly. Due to the large volume of work and the speed the work needs to be completed by, the contract was awarded to two contractors.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

Trees collectively enhance ecology in woodland areas; however, if they are dead, dying or dangerous trees they need to be addressed. Dangerous trees in the Cities woodlands need to be removed where necessary or dropped in the woods to further the ecology of the area. Also the ash trees need to be removed to try and control the emerald ash borer problem that currently exists.
