2. MARKHAM TREES FOR TOMORROW FUND, FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS - SPRING 2015

Nory Takata, Parks Planner addressed the Committee and provided a brief summary of the application for the 10,000 Trees for the Rouge in the amount of \$19,000.00.

That the funding application for 10,000 Trees for the Rouge in the amount of \$19,000 for their 26th Annual Wildlife Habitat Restoration Project in the south-east section of the Milne Park be approved.
