The Excellence through Efficiency and Effectiveness - E3 Task Force meeting convened at 1:06 p.m., with Regional Councillor Gord Landon in the Chair.

1. COMMUNITY & FIRE SERVICES

Community & Fire Services Overview

Ms. Brenda Librecz, Commissioner of Community & Fire Services delivered a PowerPoint presentation providing a brief overview of the commission.

The Committee discussed whether the list of completed E3 projects could be placed on the Town's intranet site.

Councillor Alex Chiu advised that the soccer field at Highgate Park continues to have a problem with the water not properly draining and suggested that staff look into it. There

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was brief discussion regarding the opening of soccer fields and the importance of maintaining the fields healthy for the entire season.

The Committee thanked Commissioner Librecz for her presentation and great leadership.

Fire & Emergency Services Departmental Overview

Mr. Bill Snowball, Fire Chief, delivered a PowerPoint presentation providing an overview of the Fire & Emergency Services department.

There was brief discussion with respect to regulations regarding fireworks.

The Committee inquired when staff anticipate that the Master Fire Plan will be available for review. Staff advised that it should be available in September 2011.

There was discussion regarding a future training centre in Markham.

The Committee inquired whether Fire & Emergency Services will be permitted to use the designated VIVA lanes during deployment to an emergency call. Staff advised that they are meeting with representatives of VIVA and will confirm.
