



Markham Arts & Culture Centre

- Resource centre and space for seminars, events, workshops and artist run groups to meet, work, collaborate and exchange ideas
- The MA&CC will be a hub of activity where artists, seniors, students, families, Torontonians and tourists will all come to enjoy and engage in the cultural vitality of our community and the creative expression of Markham's artists
