3. GLYNNWOOD RETIREMENT RESIDENCE	Gail Leet welcomed and introduced Mary Charbonneau, Lifestyle and Outreach Consultant at Glynnwood Retirement Residence in Thornhill. Mary Charbonneau delivered a presentation on the Retirement Home to the Committee and answered a number of questions pertaining to the administration and location of the facility. She provided information on the services provided and the benefits of living in any retirement home in Markham. Her facility is pet friendly and provides fully assisted living accommodations. 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4. OLDER ADULT STRATEGY	<p>Jason Tsien provided an update on the Older Adult Strategy. The City is currently in phase one and is investigating the services that are required now and evaluating those required for the future.</p> <p>There was discussion on the consultant's role in developing an Older Adult Strategy. Council has approved a budget for the consultant, and staff have recently submitted an application for a provincial grant. If the provincial grant is approved, both funds will be used in combination to facilitate the development of an Older Adult Strategy.</p> <p>There was significant discussion on the localization of Older Adult Strategies.</p> <p>Jason Tsien discussed the next steps with the Committee and advised that staff are working on a procurement plan for the consultant and will be bringing a draft to the Committee in the coming months. He was invited and advised that he will attend each meeting going forward to provide updates on the developing framework.</p>	
5. HEALTH & WELLNESS FAIR	<p>Janet Beatty provided the Committee with two optional dates for the Health and Wellness Fair. The Committee agreed that Thursday, November 5, 2015 would be suitable.</p> <p>The event will be held at Thornhill Community Centre and the Committee will have access to the area beginning at 9:00 am to allow for set up.</p> <p>Ideas were discussed for the fair and it was noted that this would be an information session or it could be an interactive workshop.
