
DESCRIPTION:


The installation celebrates a small piece of the natural history of this site. In cut, etched and sand-blasted Corten Steel, the piece highlights five geese taking flight. The largest in front as if parenting the others who might be taking their first major flight. The geese are oriented as if flying south for the winter and will be most striking in the fall; when the surrounding landscape takes on hues of brown, red, orange and sienna.

A laser cut Stainless Steel panel is mounted in the foreground of the piece describing the story behind the work:

"When Liberty Development Corporation began construction on this site in the spring of 2005, a family of Canada Geese were discovered nesting in the tall grass. The President of the Company, Fred Darvish, instructed that the nest be protected with fencing throughout the duration of construction until such time as the goslings were able to fly. The family of geese left the site in the fall of 2005. Together.
