

Constituent Portal Scope (Road Map)

Phase 1: New User Experience

- Redesign of Markham.ca and 7 other micro sites
 - Art Gallery, Museum, Theatre, Library, Economic Development, Small Business, Markham Centre
- New look & feel, better navigation (organization of content), improved web experience
- Meets accessibility standards (W3C) for "any user"
 - Disability, disadvantaged, elderly, children
 - Promote inclusion, increase and sustain audience
- A new content management tool
 - Scheduled content management to publish or remove, notification, robust
 - Licensing for de-centralized content management, workflow (author, approve, publish)



Constituent Portal Scope (Road Map)

Phase 1: New User Experience

- New repository for Council documents (instead of CCBS)
 - More refined search capability, robust system, easy to maintain
- A new search capability (council documents, site content, pdf etc.)
- Online forms for service request application, Eg. Garbage pickup
 - Integration with backend systems (Amanda, Hansen etc.) for processing
- Existing online pdf forms and links to applications are built in to the portal itself (as individual windows)
- Query for permit or license information etc. in Amanda
 - Services/information that do not require authentication
- Event Calendars for Council, Art Gallery, Museum, Theatre, Library etc.



Constituent Portal Scope (Road Map)

Phase 2: Self Serve

- Online payment eg. taxes, parking tickets, licenses/permits
- Single-sign-on to business applications for services
- Provide more online forms

Phase 3: Personalization


- Personalization (setting a view of their personal page)
- Enhanced single-sign-on for services, eg. view of Tax roll information
- Join communities of interest
- Interface with GIS maps

Phase 4: Mobile

- Interaction through mobile browsers for selected features
- Emergency Management Collaboration capability
- Additional self-serve features




