

Tree Restoration and Building Footprint

- In order to facilitate construction, it is currently estimated that between 3-4 trees will need to be removed
- The project will include the planting of new large calliper trees in various locations, to compensate for the loss of canopy
- The imperviousness of the site is not being increased. Therefore, there will not be any additional runoff from the site.





Proposed Exit Stair Location



























Thornhill CC&L Major Milestones
