Why BizPaL in Markham?

- Plain language, one-window access to information is essential
- 54% of firms in Ontario have 4 or fewer employees
- 74% of firms in Ontario have 9 or fewer employees

- Access to information from various jurisdictions helpful for businesses considering various locations
