## Re: Update of Population Figures on Road Signs in Area Municipalities

As you know, York Region is one of the fastest growing municipalities in all of Canada. In 2005, the Region grew at an average annual rate of approximately 3.2% or over 28,000 people. It is important that the road signs throughout the Region reflect up-to-date population figures.

Regional road signs were last updated in mid 2005 and Regional Council has directed staff to report up-to-date population figures for the annual updating of all road signs. At Council's request, this information is being forwarded to all nine area municipalities providing them with the opportunity to comment before Regional staff change the population figures on road signs. All road signs at the gateway to York Region will display the Region's population. All other population road signs within area municipalities will display area municipal population figures only.

The June 30, 2006 population estimates for the area municipalities were published in the Economic and Development Review mid year 2006 and can be found on Table 1 of the attached sheet.
