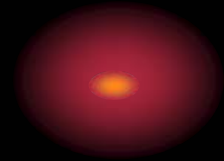


FIREWORKS

LICENSING AND TRAINING



- Repeal By-law 2001-237 and replace with a new By-law respecting the regulating, licensing, sale and discharge of fireworks



BACKGROUND

- Illegal sign for selling fireworks investigated by By-law Officer and Fire Prevention
- Upon further investigation two important matters were discussed that required changes to existing By-law



MAJOR CHANGES



- Licensing of the sales from permanent locations and mobile units.
- Restriction of all mobile sales to only not for profit or charitable organizations

MAJOR CHANGES



- Require all vendors of fireworks to attend a fireworks training and information seminar
- And that By-Law No. 2002-276, "The Fee By-Law" be amended to provide for a \$150 fee for both permanent and mobile sale of fireworks, including training.
