

BY-LAW DEFINITION: "Election Sign" means sign advertising or promoting the election of a political party or a candidate for public office in a federal, provincial, or municipal election

		May not be erected or installed earlier than <u>official date of notice of the date</u> of voting for any federal or provincial election, with the exemption of signage at a campaign headquarters	
		May not be erected or installed earlier than <u>four weeks prior to election day</u> in a municipal election, with the exemption of signage at a campaign headquarters	
		All election signs and campaign headquarters signs to be removed by midnight of the Sunday following the election	
		No restriction on the number of election signs erected at a designated campaign office, each registered candidate entitled to a single campaign office only	
		Signs must be independently attached to the ground, except for a designated campaign headquarters
