Subject: 2006 Streetlight Maintenance and Re-lamping

Dear Alan:

At your request, we are providing the proposed costing for streetlight maintenance and re-lamping program for the Town of Markham. The re-lamping program will be tracked separately and therefore will require a purchase order solely for that purpose. It should be quoted for the amount noted plus GST. A 3% increase over 2005 has been applied for this estimate.

The estimated cost for 2006 general streetlight maintenance (excluding re-lamping and hit & runs) is \$413,738.61 or a cost of \$22.58 per streetlight. Number of units is based on the 2003 total of 18,321 lights in the Town of Markham. The total inventory should be reviewed in 2006 to better reflect the number of units that will require maintenance.

The estimated cost to re-lamp 3,000 units is \$102,217.20 plus GST or \$34.07 per unit plus GST. The total number of units re-lamped in 2005 was 2,604.

Costs associated with accident (hit & run) and vandalism is estimated to be \$39,759.65 for 2006. This was based on the previous 5 years of collected data.

The repair costs for underground streetlight fault has been averaged over the past several years and for 2006 it is estimated at \$205,450.16. This estimate will vary with the actual number of faults that may occur.

If you find this information to be acceptable please forward 2 separate Purchase Orders to cover the following expenses.

Please note that the costs provided in this letter are estimates only and actual costs will depend on the actual events that occur in 2006.

A review of the general street light maintenance should be considered going forward to determine if savings can be achieved. We should review the expectations of the Town and what is determined to be acceptable turn around times from reporting to completing repairs.
