- proposed an alternative re a voucher system

7.2 Sponsorship Committee – Ron Minken, Chair

- IBM confirmed as a new sponsor of ECEY
- Miller Thomson increased their sponsorship
- Minken Jazz Series and other additional shows
- Weins Canada renewed as presenting sponsor
- Received approval from Service Canada for one summer student grant
- Department of Canadian Heritage has approved grants for 2014-2015 and 2015-2016, with an increase of \$10K from the previous applications a grant of \$60K annually, for two years, total of \$120,000.
- New Ontario Arts Council supplementary dance grant of \$5,000 will allow three dance companies to attend the Unionville Festival
