5.0 GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT – ITEMS ARISING

- media and season launches good reception at both
- both were amazing; congratulations
- very challenging winter and spring re: ticket sales/weather was a major factor
- three shows cancelled; money invested for marketing lost, direct net revenues lost: direct impact of loss \$20K to \$30K net revenue
- about \$60K under budget in ticket sales
- should catch up in the fall and balance by the end of the year
- P&L as of April 30th: City direct investment vs. total operation is 25%
- in the final stages of hiring a new Discovery Co-ordinator.

- actively pursuing sponsorship goals
- add Grade 3 for 2014-15 Season showcasing 3 distinct productions, 12 performances
- have been speaking to local private organizations who rent and have concerns re negative impact on their businesses re: Judy and David and Risa Productions
- we want to ensure that we find a viable solution in making sure we will support a vibrant arts community, which we believe can co-habit successfully with ECEY
- Discovery committee met with David Gershon who's primary concern is the economic impact on his business/listened to his proposal as to how to run ECEY/he proposed a voucher program create a voucher like a ticket accessible to all Markham students/schools can decide which to go to ECEY or their shows or any shows from other school matinees at the Theatre. David is concerned that other venues will start similar programs and that it will hurt the industry at large.
- The committee asked him to provide a list of schools they've sold tickets to/how many of their students are actually from Markham?

- so far, no disclosure other than some vague information; Mr. Gershon has not answered the committee inquiry to get information – critical to make an objective analysis of the situation with clarity – seems that it is not likely that we will receive this information
- other programs are being offered by the Theatre at a cost in 2014-2015 season which compete with ECEY
- a suggestion is made to register ECEY as a separate entity re: not for profit private organization/charity? It would also help with sponsorships and fundraising
- a much bigger issue that we should explore; done in the US
- committee to meet before the next board meeting to come up with a strategy
- will pass a resolution at the June meeting
- impact of the program could be positive for their business; can't be predicted
- Theatre is willing to examine how it would be able to support marketing efforts of producers promoting school matinees to York Region school market.
- Theatre's ECEY flyer only goes to Markham schools/Discovery paid-for matinees will be circulated to all York Region schools
