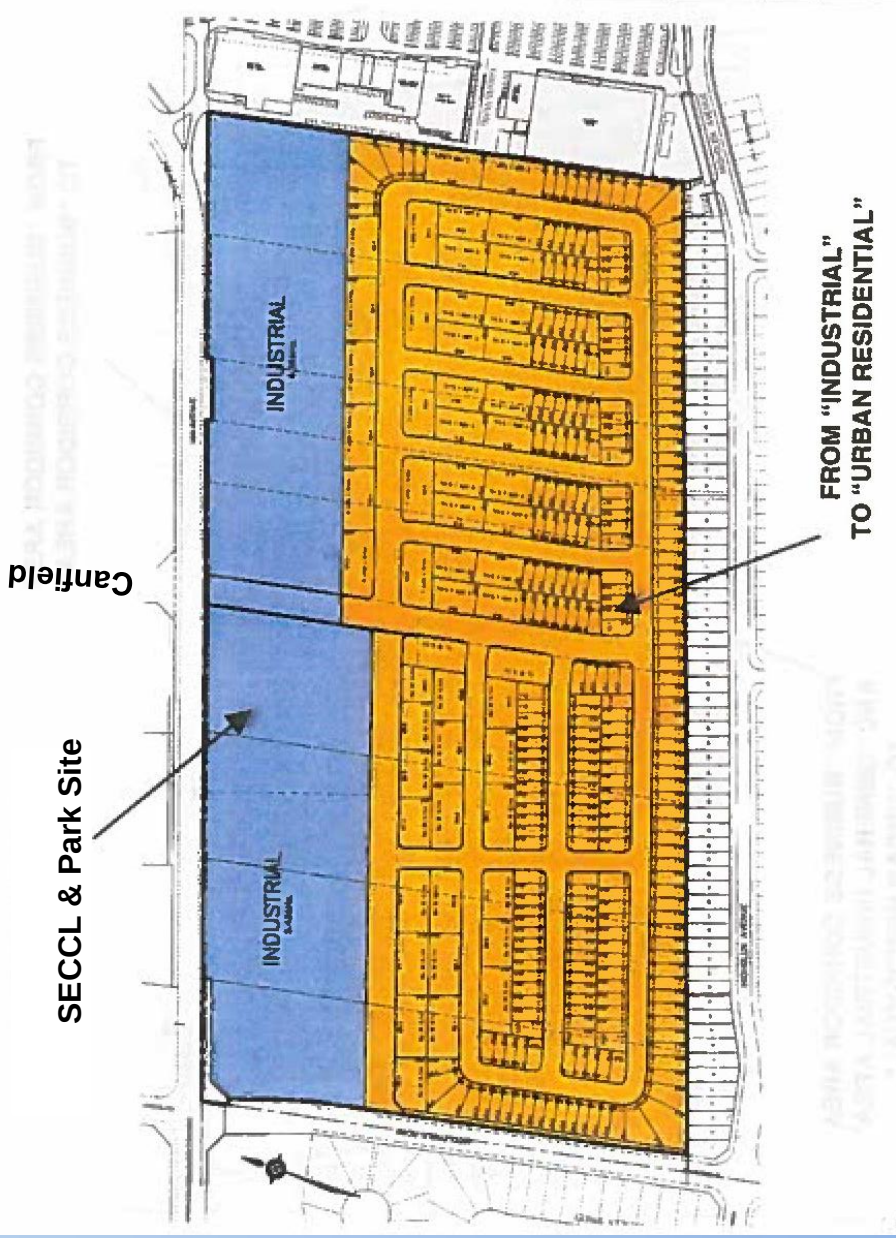

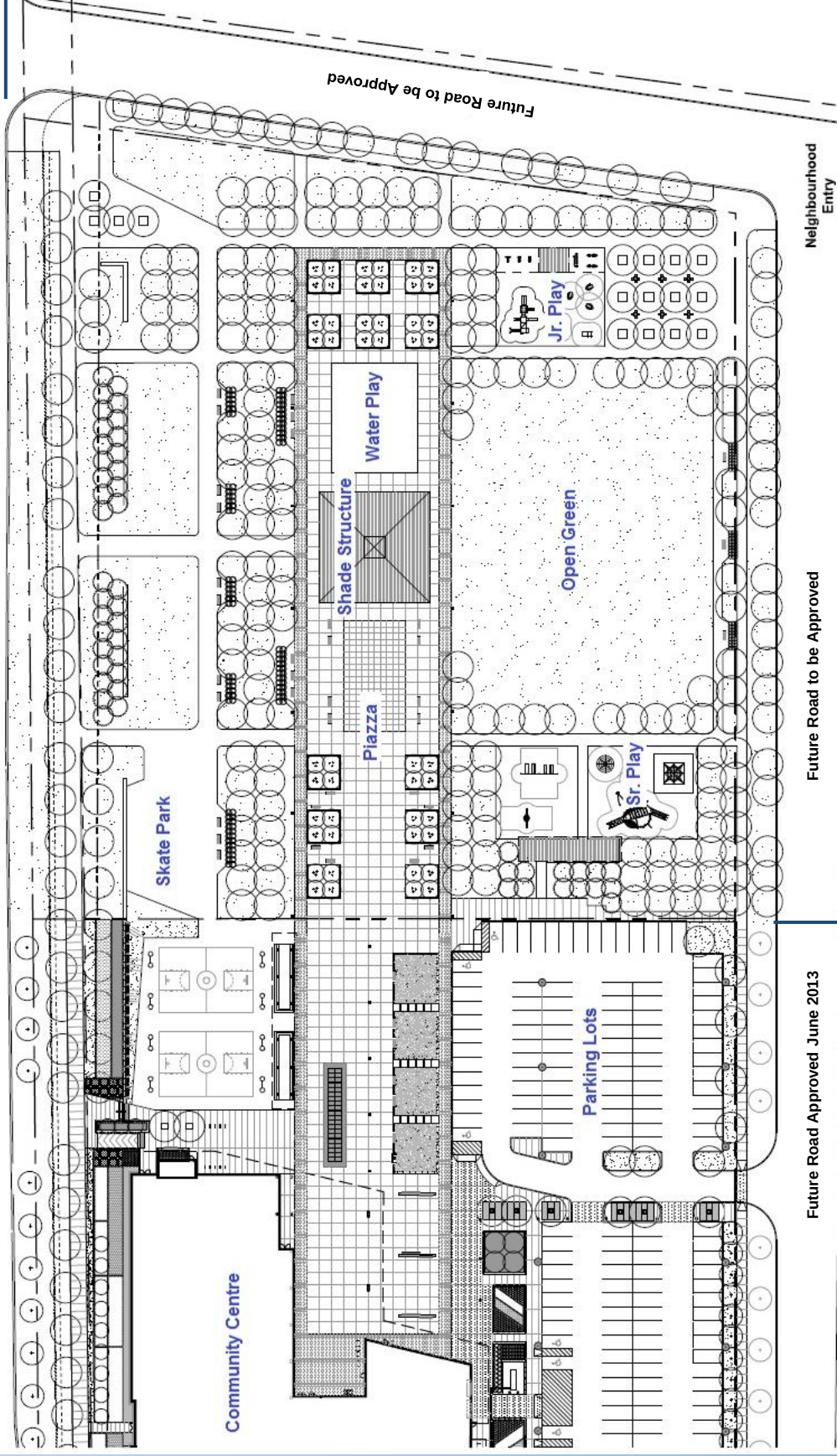

Construction & Park Completion

- Public Consultation: Scheduled for 25 September 2014.
 - To be held in conjunction with Kirkham Drive Park Community Consultation Meeting
- Concept Design Approval: October 2014
- Detail Design: Fall 2014
- Park Acquisition: January 2015
- Tender Release: February 2015
- Contract Award: March 2015
- Begin Construction: April 2015
- Park Completion: Spring 2016
