



BY-LAW 2011-74

TO AMEND BY-LAW 203-86
Being a By-law to Prohibit Retail Sales on Municipal Highways

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham enacted By-law 203-86 on June 3, 1986 to prohibit retail sales on municipal highways and to provide penalties for violations thereof; and

Whereas Section 16 of By-law 436-86, in accordance with the *Provincial Offences Act*, prescribes the offence and penalty provisions; and

Whereas the penalty provisions of the *Provincial Offences Act* are from time to time amended; and

Whereas replacing Section 3 of the By-law 203-86 with a generalized section will facilitate any amendments made to the *Provincial Offences Act*;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following Section 3 of By-law 203-86 be deleted in its entirety:

“Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to fine of not more than \$2,000.00.”, and

2. That the following be inserted as Section 3 to By-law 203-86:

“Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P-33, as amended.”
