

BY-LAW 2010-30

A by-law authorizing the provision of election information in languages other than English and French

WHEREAS Subsection 9.1 (3) of the <u>Municipal Elections Act, 1996</u> provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law allowing the use of languages other than English and French in notices, forms (other than prescribed forms) and other information related to an election, by-election or referendum.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Markham is represented by many diverse cultures and language groups;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk/Returning Officer has an obligation to engage voters in the electoral process by providing relevant and comprehendible information.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham enacts as follows:

1. Election, by-election and referendum information may be made available in languages other than English and French at the discretion of the Clerk.
