



## BY-LAW 2010-31

A by-law to amend By-law No. 2002-276  
being a by-law to impose fees or charges for services or  
activities provided or done by the Town of Markham  
(Update Waste Management fees)

WHEREAS paragraph 391(a) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and;

WHEREAS Council at its meeting held on March 9, 2010 approved the increase of user fees and service charges to reflect new Waste Management fees;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 2002-276, being a by-law to impose fees or charges for services or activities provided or done by the Town of Markham, be amended as follows:

**Delete the following fees from "Community Services – Waste":**

**Add the following fees to "Community Services - Waste":**

Green Bins	\$20.00	Each
Kitchen Collectors	\$7.00	Each
60 litre Blue Box	\$8.00	Each
80 litre Blue Box	\$12.00	Each
New Home Recycling Kit (2-60 litre Blue Boxes, 1 Green Bin, 1 Kitchen Collector, Delivery)	\$53.00	Per household
New Multi-residential Unit Recycling Kit (1 Apartment Recycling Blue Bag, 1 Kitchen Collector, Delivery)	\$23.00	Per unit
White Goods Collection	\$10.00	Per unit
Apartment Recycling Blue Bag	\$6.00	Each

2. That all other provisions of By-law 2002-276, as amended, not inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law shall continue to apply.
3. That this by-law come into force and effect on the 1st day of April, 2010.
