



## BY-LAW 2008-98

A By-law to amend By-law 2006-97

(A By-law to Regulate or Prohibit Removal of Topsoil, Placing or Dumping of Fill,  
and Alteration of the Grade of Land within the Town of Markham)

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM  
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

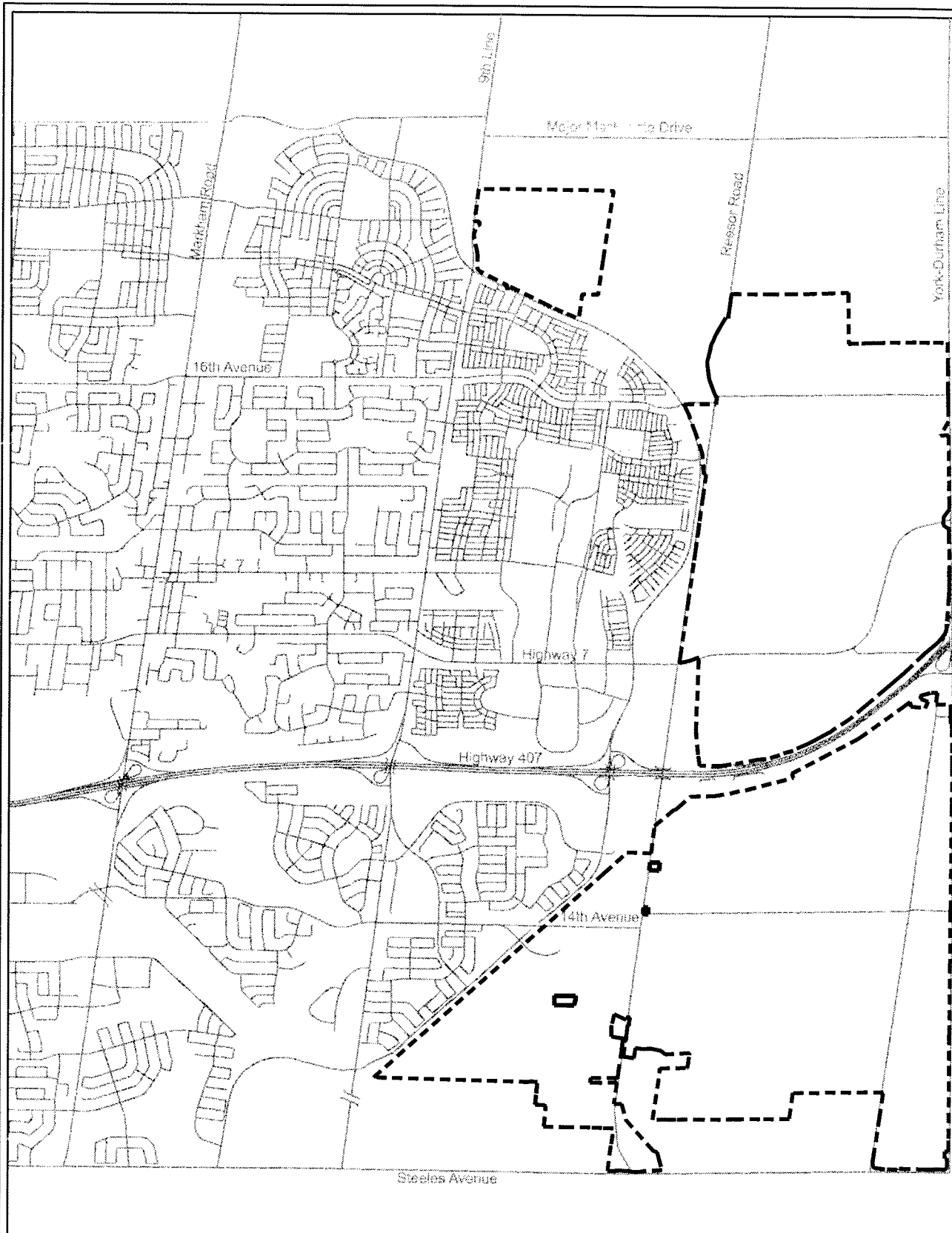
1. That By-law 2006-97 be hereby amended by adding a new subsection to section 4 as follows:
  - “4.1.12 The issuance of a permit for Rouge Park projects within the area identified on Schedule ‘G’ to this By-law are exempt from the requirements of Section 4.1, subject to the Director of Engineering being satisfied that appropriate information has been submitted and the following conditions have been satisfied:
    - 4.1.12.1 The proposal is located on the lands identified as Schedule ‘G’;
    - 4.1.12.2 Toronto Region Conservation Authority and all other applicable agencies approvals have been received;
    - 4.1.12.3 No or a negligible amount of fill is imported or exported; and
    - 4.1.12.4 The proposal does not conflict with other planned Town projects”.
2. That By-law 2006-97 be hereby amended by adding a new subsection under "Schedules", Section 15, as follows:

"15.7 Schedule "G" Eastern Markham Rouge Park Lands"
3. All other provisions of By-law 2006-97, as amended, not inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law shall continue to apply.
4. This By-law shall take effect and come into force upon its passing.
