Re: Business Licensing By-laws 2002-284, 2002-286, 2002-287, 2002-288,

2002-290, 2002-291, 2002-292, 2002-293, 2002-294, 2002-295, 2002-296, 2002-297, 2002-298, 002-299, 2002-301, 2002-302, 2002-303, 2002-304, 2002-305, 2002-306, 2002-307, 2002-308, 2002-309, and 2002-310

On December 10, 2002, Council passed a number of By-laws to licence, regulate and govern various local businesses. The authority for a municipality to licence businesses is contained in the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25.

In accordance with Section 150 (13) of the *Municipal Act*, at that time, a business licensing by-law expired five years after it came into force or when repealed, whichever occurred first. The above-mentioned Business Licensing By-laws each contain a clause that states that the by-law was effective from its passage and would remain so until December 31, 2007. The Section of the Municipal Act requiring business licensing by-laws to expire five years from their passage has since been deleted, and therefore, the Business Licensing by-laws should be amended by the removal of the reference to their expiration in December, 2007.

In order that the aforementioned by-laws continue in effect beyond December 31, 2007, staff is recommending that the attached By-law be enacted.

BY-LAW 2007-

A By-law to amend By-laws 2002-284, 2002-286, 2002-287, 2002-288, 2002-290, 2002-291, 2002-292, 2002-293, 2002-294, 2002-295, 2002-296, 2002-297, 2002-298, 2002-299, 2002-301, 2002-302, 2002-303, 2002-304, 2002-305, 2002-306 2002-307, 2002-308, 2002-309, 2002-310

WHEREAS Sections, 9, 10, 11 and 151 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, authorize municipalities to licence, regulate and govern any business wholly or partly carried on within the municipality; and

WHEREAS By-laws 2002-284, 2002-286, 2002-287, 2002-288, 2002-290, 2002-291, 2002-292, 2002-293, 2002-294, 2002-295, 2002-296, 2002-297, 2002-298, 002-299, 2002-301, 2002-302, 2002-303, 2002-304, 2002-305, 2002-306, 2002-307, 2002-308, 2002-309, and 2002-310, provide for the regulating and licensing of various businesses carried on within Markham; and

WHEREAS Section 150 (13) of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001*, required that all Bylaws enacted to licence businesses expire five years after their coming into force, and the above-referenced By-laws were subsequently amended by adding a clause to cause the Bylaws to remain in effect until December 31, 2007, and

WHEREAS Section 150 (13) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, was repealed,

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

- 1. That By-laws 2002-284, 2002-286, 2002-287, 2002-288, 2002-290, 2002-291, 2002-292, 2002-293, 2002-294, 2002-295, 2002-296, 2002-297, 2002-298, 002-299, 2002-301, 2002-302, 2002-303, 2002-304, 2002-305, 2002-306, 2002-307, 2002-308, 2002-309, and 2002-310, be amended by deleting there from all references to their remaining in effect until December 31, 2007.
- 2. This By-law will take effect and come into force upon its passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS DAY OF DECEMBER, 2007.
