Letter of Engagement - Conservation & Demand Management Partnership

I am pleased to advise you that PowerStream Inc. will enter into a formal partnership with Markham ECO to deliver specified Conservation & Demand Management (CDM) programs in the Markham sector of PowerStream's service territory.

As you are aware, these community partnerships form a key component of PowerStream's strategy for the delivery and execution of our CDM programs to our customers. We are pleased that Markham ECO has agreed to work with us in this capacity.

As PowerStream's CDM program is being financed by the "third tranche" funding provision approved by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) as part of PowerStream's 2005 distribution rate application, all investments must be cost effective and satisfy a postmortem OEB prudency review. Consequently, all projects will be subject to a Total Resource Cost test to allow for benchmarking and eventual reporting to the OEB.

The three-year funding pattern for our partnership is depicted in the following table. Please note two important qualifications:

- The funding of future-period projects is directly dependent upon program performance in the current period; and
- Due to the mid-2005 commencement of the program and required start-up activities, the funding provision for the calendar year 2005 is expected to only partially align with actual program spending, i.e. a segment of the 2005 funding provision will be deployed in early 2006.
