

Toronto 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games-Markham Pan Am Host Advisory Committee

Terms of Reference June 17, 2013

Purpose

The TO2015 Organizing Committee has identified that a high priority of the games is to engage the local community in the celebration of sport and culture. The intent of developing a community engagement strategy is to ensure that residents of the host communities truly embrace the games and understand the value of the games from a sport, cultural and legacy perspective.

The mission of Markham's Community Engagement Strategy is to involve the Markham Community in leadership, volunteerism, sport and cultural development, legacy building, healthy active living, business development/tourism and celebration for the Toronto 2015 Pan /Parapan Am Games.

The Toronto 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games - Markham Pan Am Host Advisory Committee will be a multi-sectoral, high-level leadership team working with the City of Markham to leverage resources, build partnerships, and increase profile of Markham's Pan Am events leading up to the Toronto 2015 Pan Am /Parapan Am Games. The committee would be chaired by the Mayor and the composition would consist of eight to twelve top level executives/leaders from corporate, business, education, sport, culture and social service sectors.

Overall Objective:

 To leverage resources, build partnerships, and increase profile of Markham's Pan Am events leading up to the Pan Am Games.

Host Committee Outcomes:

The Markham Pan Am Host Advisory Committee will;

- Ensure that the residents of Markham are fully informed and engaged in the 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games by ensuring the Community Enagement Strategy is implemented.
- Ensure that legacy programs developed in sport and culture will be sustainable within our community.
- Ensure that the City of Markham leverages all opportunities during the pre-game, games and post-games times to profile the City of Markham.
- Build partnerships within community to help support the games, and ongoing sport tourism in our community.

Mandate

The mandate of the Toronto 2015 Pan Am/Parapan Am Games – Markham Pan Am Host Advisory Committee will be to identify opportunities to create and activate residents of Markham to embrace the games, and to understand the value of the games from a sport, cultural and legacy perspective. To provide oversight and guidance to the various sub committees that will be formed including: Legacy development, Volunteer activation, Cultural celebration, and Community celebration.

Deliverables:

- 1. Provide leadership and advice to the City of Markham in the implementation of the Pan Am Community Engagement Strategy. (PACES)
- 2. Receive regular, formal updates from staff and the Sub Committee Chairs.
- 3. Provide quarterly report to Markham Council on the progress of the Community Engagement Strategy.
