1. Call to Order	The Advisory Committee on Accessibility convened at 3:39 p.m. with Sidney Polak presiding as Chair.	
2. Main Street Markham Design	Sally Campbell, Senior Planner Urban Design, was in attendance to provide an update on the accessibility enhancements on Main Street Markham. Some of these enhancements included: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A continuous 2 metre sidewalk;• 3 new accessible parking spots;• Urban Brail marking the line between the sidewalk and the road;• The street name impressed into the sidewalk for the visually impaired;• Trees will be planted below the boulevard so that nobody trips and falls over the roots;• Audible crossing signals;• A loading area with a dropped curve;• More levelled sidewalks;• Introduction of a new intersection by the Church to help residents cross the street;• Working with businesses on Main Street Markham to improve their accessibility (e.g. possibly creating an opportunity for businesses to undertake accessibility enhancements through the City's contractor).	The Committee requested that staff ensure that urban brail is an approved method of marking the sidewalk from the street by the Canadian National Institute of the Blind

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	<p>(CNIB). In addition, there was some concern that people with a cane or walker may trip over the impressed street names being proposed to be placed on the sidewalks.</p> <p>The Committee was asked if it had any accessibility concerns with having a restaurant patio extend vertically in front of the store front and with the sidewalk going around the patio. The Committee had mixed opinions with respect to this matter.</p> <p>A Sub-Committee was formed to review the plans for Main Street Markham in more detail:</p> <p>Moved by Robert Hunn Seconded by Councillor Don Hamilton</p> <p>That a Sub-Committee of the Advisory Committee on Accessibility be formed to review and provide feedback on the proposed designs for Main Street Markham; and,</p> <p>That the following members be appointed:</p> <p>Sidney Polak Robert Hunn Councillor Don Hamilton Graham Seaman</p>	<p>Investigate whether urban brail is an approved method for marking the line between the road and the sidewalk by the CNIB – Sally Campbell</p> <p>Meet to provide feedback on the Main Street Markham designs – Main Street Markham Design Sub-Committee</p> <p>Set up a meeting for the Main Street Markham Design Sub-Committee in the second week of January - Committee Clerk</p> <p>CARRIED</p> <p>The Committee Clerk was requested to set up a meeting for the Main Street Markham Design Sub-Committee in the second week of January 2013.</p> <p>A Committee Member expressed their concern regarding the accessibility of the sidewalks on Highway 7.</p>
3. Committee Communications	Diane Samek, Senior Advisor, Communications & Marketing, was in attendance to speak about ways of promoting accessibility related matters within the City of Markham. It was suggested that the Committee think about who it would like to reach in its promotional efforts.	Email Promotion Sub-

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	<p>It was advised that the brochure prepared by Excellence Canada promoting access to businesses could be bookmarked to develop a similar brochure for the City of Markham. Sid Polak will provide Diane Samek with a copy of the Excellence Canada brochure.</p> <p>Members thought that a simple brochure could be used to promote accessibility within the City of Markham.</p> <p>It was agreed that the Committee should focus on promoting the following: (1) the accessibility fair; (2) the accessibility guidelines; (3) the Markham Advisory Committee on Accessibility; (4) the Board of Trade Accessibility Award; and (5) the benefits businesses will derive from making their business accessible.</p> <p>It was suggested that this Committee could make improvements to the accessibility section of the website (e.g. adding frequently asked questions regarding accessibility to the website and adding a place where residents can identify their accessibility concerns). The Promotion Sub-Committee was delegated this task. Staff will report back on this matter at the next meeting.</p> <p>It was noted that staff are trying to come up with a more permanent solution to enhancing the accessibility of Main Street Markham, as it is currently undergoing significant renovations.</p>

It was recommended that the second paragraph of the Terms of Reference be changed to say:</p> <p>“The Markham Advisory Committee on Accessibility will contribute to a community that is recognized as providing promoting excellent accessibility in both the public and private sector”.</p> <p>It was advised that the two bullets on conducting public audits are being removed from the Terms of Reference, as this is an activity that the Committee is not currently undertaking. Rather accessibility concerns are discussed by the Committee based on Members experiences.</p> <p>The final approval of the Terms of Reference was deferred to the next meeting.</p>	<p>Approve revised version of Terms of Reference at the next meeting – All Committee Members</p>
