2. SITE DEVELOPMENT AND PARK DEVELOPMENT CONCEPT

Staff provided some opening remarks relative to the relationship between the piazza, park and building.

Brad Fleisher, FRP Inc. delivered a PowerPoint presentation outlining proposed landscape development concepts and proposed site development concepts.

The Committee discussed the features they like and don't like relative to the proposed site plan options.

The Committee made the following suggestions to be considered:

- Do not include movable planters
- Ensure Tai Chi can be done in the urban square area (northwest corner of the site)
- Like the triangular pattern in the hard landscaping that ties in with the building
- Do not like the idea of the large rock
- Like the trees maybe only a single row
- Important to ensure it is a seamless transition from the community centre and library, to the parking lot and to the park
- Bring the tree treatment down closer to the park
- Consider duplicate seats down to the west and further to the bottom
- The proposed "red ball" should be re-locate
- Move the pergola to the south
- Proposed artificial turf is a good idea, but review appropriate location
- Proposed Concept B is the closest to the vision

Staff distributed a "Park Development Concept" and will review at the next meeting.
