2. LATEST BUILDING PLANS

Duff Balmer, Perkins + Will delivered a PowerPoint presentation providing an update relative to the building plan.

The Committee discussed the following:

- Ability to make the swimming area private through the use of blinds for "women only" swimming
- The various proposed aquatic features such as aqua climb and lazy river
- Size difference between this pool area compared to the Cornell Community Centre
- Is the viewing area for the pool area large enough
- Should the viewing area for the pool area be angled to increase viewing to the lane pool
- Gymnasium size is very similar to the gymnasium at the Cornell Community Centre
- Can gymnasium be used for soccer (young children)
- Can seating be included at the end of the lane pool area
- Ensure the acoustics in the gathering area is sufficient for performances
- Bring back various set-ups for the gathering space to be reviewed
- Can there be potential to add backs to seats in the gathering space area

Councillor Logan Kanapathi suggested that staff review the various proposed usages of the spaces within the Library area with him.

3. UNIVERSAL CHANGE ROOM CONCEPT

Mary Creighton, Director Recreation delivered a PowerPoint presentation introducing the concept of universal change rooms.

Duff Balmer reviewed the proposed design for the universal change rooms. There was brief discussion with respect to the purpose of having the universal change rooms separated.

It was noted that the City of Toronto - Regent Park Aquatic Centre that opened in November 2012 has Universal Change rooms. Councillor Logan Kanapathi suggested that staff set up a site visit to the Regent Park Aquatic Centre to view the universal change room.
