1. MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 11, 2012 SOUTHEAST COMMUNITY CENTRE & LIBRARY DESIGN SUBCOMMITTEE

2. SUSTAINABILITY OPTION

Graham Seaman, Sustainability Office Lead and Manager of Climate Change & Energy delivered a PowerPoint presentation providing a detailed analysis for achieving LEED Gold and the 45% and 60% higher than the National Energy Code for Building Standards (NECB) sustainability initiatives.

There was brief discussion regarding the vertical axis turbine as a feature to review.

The Committee suggested that staff proceed with Option 2. It was suggested that staff investigate PowerStream's position relative to the design costs (\$128,340).

The Committee requested further information regarding the design fee. Staff confirmed that the estimated cost for the design fee is 6% of the budget cost of this project. Total soft cost for additional scope is estimated at 7% of the estimated construction cost.

That staff proceed with Option 2 - Target LEED Gold; and,

That staff continues to further research how to deploy solar.
