2. PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING RESULTS

There was considerable discussion regarding whether the Community Centre should include a "quiet room" that is not programmed and could be used for various activities (such as first aide room, prayer space, small meetings, etc). Staff advised that they need to do more research and will report back to Committee on this suggestion.

3. BUILDING SITE DESIGN DISCUSSION

Brad Fleisher, FRP Inc. delivered a PowerPoint presentation outlining the building site design.

The Committee discussed the following:

- How will the northeast corner of the property be landscaped
- Importance of functionality within the centre - how does space get used
- Ensure proper connection from the outdoor space into the facility

4. PARK DESIGN PRINCIPLES

Linda Irvine, Manager, Parks and Open Space Development provided opening comments relative to the park development concepts.

Mr. Fleisher delivered a PowerPoint presentation outlining the park development concepts.

The Committee discussed the following:

- Consider including games like "life size chess" in the outdoor
- Ensure there are no back lots facing the park
- Consider including a Tai Chi area that is covered
- The importance of seamless connectivity between the outdoor space to the facility
- Investigate a combination of "approach 2 & 4"
- Whether on street parking would be permitted
