- Outreach and education add value, sustain interest




# Distribution

## Above and Beyond

- Woodlot restoration
- Invasive species removal
- Restoring native plant biodiversity



# Community Cleanups

- 1000 + participants annually
- Significant volunteer time commitment
- Fosters pride and social cohesion that shapes neighbourhood identity



# ‘One-of’ Volunteer Events

- 25 + separate events with 700+ volunteers
- Environmental Stewardship: tree maintenance, invasive species removal and park cleanups
  - Volunteers highly motivated and productive



# Local Park Programs

- Winter Programming: Volunteer Ice Rinks
- Dog Off-Leash Program
- Parks Ambassadors Program



# Volunteer Ice Rink Program

- 10 Volunteer Ice Rinks installed for 2010-11 season
- Labour intensive, ongoing commitment of dedicated volunteers
- Community Building through shared activity



## Dog Off-Leash Program

- New Off-Leash Area in Huntington Park - July 2011
- Volunteer driven: oversee day to day park operation
- Volunteers commit many hours per annum
- Reduced demand on staff resources



# Contributory Value

## Volunteer Time Commitment

- 2,000 + Volunteers
- Average 3.5 hours / volunteer time
- ~7,000 hours

## Qualitative Benefits

### Community Engagement:

- Enhances ecological health, aesthetic appeal & community pride
- Public space contributes to local identity and affirms sense of community
