PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval for Ernie Ting, Manager of Infrastructure, Waterworks and Councillor Alex Chiu to attend the North American Society of Trenchless Technology's (NASTT) "No-Dig Show 2012" conference and exhibition.

BACKGROUND:

The annual No-Dig Conference and Exhibition will be held on March 11-15, 2012, in Nashville, Tennessee. This annual event presents technical and research papers, case studies, asset management, condition assessment, exposition and demonstration of products and equipment on trenchless technology installation, rehabilitation and replacement of underground municipal infrastructure. Trenchless technologies are methods of maintenance, repairs or rehabilitation of underground infrastructures (water and sewer systems) with minimal and mostly no excavation.

Participants at this conference share their knowledge, findings and experiences in underground trenchless rehabilitation, new techniques, development and advances in materials and equipment.

As a past Director of NASTT, Ernie Ting continues to be an active member of the No-Dig Program Committee. As a NASTT Program Committee member, session leader and moderator, he is expected to attend the program committee meeting on Saturday, March 10, 2012 and Regional Chapter Networking Meeting on Sunday, March 11, 2012. As a session leader for the conference, Mr. Ting will be exempted from the registration fee.

As chair of the Town's Community and Fire Services Committee, Councillor Alex Chiu's attendance to this conference will be beneficial in learning new technologies for sustainable municipal infrastructure and its social and environmental benefits. It will widen his

perspective and understanding in asset management, sustainability, cost effective maintenance, infrastructure lifecycle and financial impact. He would also benefit in attending the Sunday, March 11 Regional Chapters Networking Reception and Meeting to meet various chapter directors, members and other stakeholders to discuss and learn from their own experiences
