1. OPENING REMARKS AND INTRODUCTIONS

The Chair welcomed the new members. The Committee Members briefly introduced themselves.

a. Accessibility of the Underground Parking lot a Markham Civic Centre

The Town is working on establishing an Accommodation Policy for employees and visitors that will address issues such as parking in the underground parking lot.

The Developer agreed to implement the recommended changes.

It was reported that Le Parc will notify the Committee when its recommendations regarding the other accessibility concerns are addressed.

It was suggested that improvements be made to the curve cut on Yonge Street between Clark Avenue and Centre Street due to accessibility concerns.

It was noted that the Fitness Depot located on Glen Cameron does not have an accessible front entrance. Accessible patron need to call in advance to enter the store through the loading dock.
