PURPOSE:

To obtain Council approval for the Treasurer to have authority to make payments necessary to support the ongoing business of the Town, prior to approval of the 2012 Operating Budget.

BACKGROUND:

The 2012 Interim Spending Authority is intended to allow each of the Town's operating departments and the Waterworks department to spend up to 50% of the 2011 approved operating budget. This approval will enable the Town operations to continue at existing approved service levels until the Town's 2012 Budget has been approved.
