

BY-LAW 2011-XX

A By-law to amend By-law 248-1999, as amended (A by-law to establish standards for the maintenance and occupancy of property in the Town of Markham. Property Standards By-law)

WHEREAS section 142 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes municipal councils to pass by-laws to regulate or prohibit the removal of topsoil, the placing or dumping of fill, and the alteration of the grade of land;

AND WHEREAS sections 15.1 to 15.8 of the *Building Code Act*, 1992, S.O. 1992, c.23, as amended, (the "Act") authorizes Council to pass by-laws to establish property policies and standards relating to property within the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MARKHAM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law 248-1999 be hereby amended by the addition of a definition in section 2 as follows:
 - "<u>Director of Engineering</u>" means the Director of Engineering of the Town, or his/her designate;
- 2. That By-law 248-1999 be hereby amended by the addition of subsection 11(9) as follows:
 - "11(9) Lot grading shall be maintained by one of the following means:
 - (a) by maintaining the existing drainage pattern, matching the existing grading of neighbouring properties, and conformity with the current Town Engineering Design Criteria and Standard Drawings;
 - (b) with an original lot grading plan as approved by the Town; or
 - (c) in accordance with a plan approved by the Director of Engineering."
- 3. All other provisions of By-law 248-1999, as amended, not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law shall continue to apply.
- 4. This By-law shall take effect and come into force upon its passing.
