

A by-law to amend Fence By-law No. 277-97

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham (hereinafter the "Town") is authorized by section 9, subsection 11 (1), paragraph 11(3) 7 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, (hereinafter the "Municipal Act") provides that a municipality may pass by-laws within the sphere of jurisdiction entitled Structures, including fences and signs;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 277-97 be amended as follows:
  - (a) By Adding the following as Section 19 Service Fees immediately after Section 18.0 Penalty Provisions:

## "Section 19 Service Fees

- 19.1 The municipal service fees for the administration and enforcement of this By-law shall be in accordance with the City's Fees By-law and any revisions thereto.
- 19.2 Service fees for the administration and enforcement of this By-law may be applied when a contravention has been confirmed by a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer."
- (b) By Adding the following as Section 20 Collection of Unpaid Fines immediately after Section 19.0 Service Fees:

## "Section 20 Collection of Unpaid Fines

- 20.1 Pursuant to subsection 441.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the **Treasurer** of the **City** may add any part of a fine for a commission of a provincial offence that is in default under section 69 of the *Provincial Offences Act* to the tax roll for any property in the **City** which all of the **Owners** are responsible for."
- 2. That the Sections following Section 20 be renumbered accordingly.
- 3. That this by-law comes into force and takes effect upon its passage.
- 4. All other provisions of By-law 277-97, except as herein amended or effected, which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, shall continue to apply.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed this 12th day of September, 2018.
