



## By-law 2018-113

**To amend Bylaw 2002-94 being a By-law to Prohibit and Regulate Signs and other Advertising Devices and the Posting of Notices on Building or Vacant Lots within the City of Markham.  
(Amendments to Sign By-law)**

---

**WHEREAS** s. 11(3) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that Councils of lower-tier municipalities may pass by-laws respecting matters pertaining to structures, including fences and signs.

**AND WHEREAS** administrative amendments are required from time to time for enforcement purposes;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF MARKHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 2002-94 be amended as follows:

(a) By Adding the following as Section 21 – Service Fees immediately after Section 20.0 Penalties and Enforcement:

**"Section 21 Service Fees**

21.1 The municipal service fees for the administration and enforcement of this By-law shall be in accordance with the City's Fees By-law and any revisions thereto.

21.2 Service fees for the administration and enforcement of this By-law may be applied when a contravention has been confirmed by a **Municipal Law Enforcement Officer.**"

(b) By Adding the following as Section 22 – Collection of Unpaid Fines immediately after Section 21.0 Service Fees:

**"Section 22 Collection of Unpaid Fines**


22.1 Pursuant to subsection 441.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the **Treasurer** of the City may add any part of a fine for a commission of a provincial offence that is in default under section 69 of the *Provincial Offences Act* to the tax roll for any property in the City which all of the **Owners** are responsible for."


2. That the Sections following Section 22 be renumbered accordingly.

3. That this by-law comes into force and takes effect upon its passage.

4. All other provisions of By-law 2002-94, except as herein amended or effected, which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, shall continue to apply.
