

By-law 2018-26

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Part of Lots 25 and 26, Plan 65M-2230, designated as Parts 5, 7, 8, 9 and 38, Plan 65R-29149, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to the Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

And Whereas Part of Lot 5, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Parts 1, 6, 8, 10, and 12, Plan D1004, Part of Lot 7, Plan 65M-2616 designated as Parts 17, 18, 20 and 22, Plan D1004 and Part of Lot 24, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Part 14, Plan D1004 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were expropriated by the City of Markham for municipal purposes.

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

The following lands in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York are hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Birchmount Road:

- Part of Lot 26, Plan 65M-2230, designated as Part 5, Plan 65R-29149;
- Part of Lot 25, Plan 65M-2230, designated as Parts 7, 8, 9 and 38, Plan 65R-
- Part of Lot 5, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Parts 1, 6, 8, 10 and 12, Plan D1004; Part of Lot 6, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Part 15, Plan D1004;
- Part of Lot 7, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Parts 17, 18, 20 and 22, Plan D1004; and
- Part Lot 24, Plan 65M-2616, designated as Part 14, Plan D1004.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on April 24, 2018.
