

By-Law 2018-29

A by-law to amend By-law No. 2012-137, being a by-law to impose fees or charges for licences and permits issued by the City of Markham

Whereas paragraph 391(a) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; and,

Whereas administrative amendments are needed to By-law 2012-137 for enforcement purposes;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the following be added under "Section 1 Definitions" immediately following the definition of "Mobile Business":
 - ""Municipal Law Enforcement Officer" ("Officer") means an employee of the City who has been appointed by By-law to enforce the provisions of City By-laws or a member of the York Regional Police and includes his or her designates;
- 2. That the following be added under "Section 2 Requirements to Payees and Charges" as Section 2.3 and 2.4:
 - "2.3 The municipal fees payable by **Owner** or by any other **Person** for the administration and enforcement of this By-law shall be in accordance with the fees established by the **City** under the Licensing, Permit and Service Fees By-law and any revisions thereto.
 - 2.4 Fees for the administration and enforcement of this By-law may be applied when a contravention has been confirmed by an **Officer**.
- 3. That the word "permanent" be added to "Placement of Mobile, Portable and Banner Sign Wall and Ground Signs", under the column "Term" contained in Schedule A.
- 4. That this by-law comes into force and takes effect upon its passage.
- 5. All other provisions of By-law 2012-137, except as herein amended or effected, which are not inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, shall continue to apply.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed this 24th day of April, 2018.
