



By-law 2018-10

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as
part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Blocks 7 and 8, Plan 65M-4458, Blocks 284, 285, 286 and 287, Plan 65M-3840 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York were conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Block 7, Plan 65M-4458 and Block 284, Plan 65M-3840, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Montague's Lane.
2. That Block 8, Plan 65M-4458 and Block 287, Plan 65M-3840, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Lindcrest Manor.
3. That Block 285, Plan 65M-3840, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named The Barley Lea Street.
4. That Block 286, Plan 65M-3840, in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Lane 3.
