



By-law 2017-18

A by-law to dedicate certain lands as
part of the highways of the City of Markham

The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Block 13, Plan 65M-3019 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York was conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

Whereas Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Block CX, Plan M-1475 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York was conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;


And Whereas Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Part 8, Plan 65M-28640 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York was conveyed to The Corporation of the City of Markham for public use;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Block 13, 65M-3019 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Lichfield Road.
2. That Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Block CX, Plan M-1475 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Lichfield Road.
3. That Part of Lot 11, Concession 5, designated as Part 8, Plan 65M-28640 in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York is hereby established and laid out as part of the public highways of the City of Markham and named Lichfield Road.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on April 11, 2017.
