



By-law 2016-92

A by-law to change a certain street name
in the City of Markham

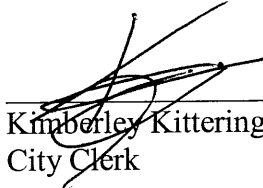
The Corporation of the Town of Markham has changed its name to The Corporation of the City of Markham by By-law No. 2012-120 enacted and passed May 29, 2012, effective July 1, 2012, as evidenced in Instrument No. YR1847438 registered June 29, 2012.

Whereas Section 27 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25*, as amended, provides that a Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to change the name of a highway;

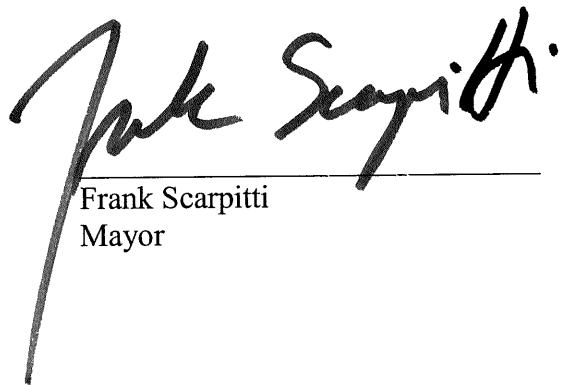
Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That a lane in the City of Markham, Regional Municipality of York, legally described as Block 43 on Registered Plan 65M-4496, be named John Rudkin Lane; and
2. That the provisions of this by-law shall take effect at such time as a certified copy of same certified under the hand of the Clerk and the seal of the Corporation has been registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of York Region (No. 65).

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on September 13, 2016.
