ALTERNATE ROUTE

- 1. From Bullock Drive \ west to Hawkridge Ave to Hwy 7
- 2. From Hwy 7 north of Hawkridge Ave east on Bullock Drive to Main Street North
- 3. From east on Parkway Ave to south on George Street Washington Street to Hwy 7
- 4. From Hwy 7 north on Washington Street & George Street to Parkway Ave west to Main St North

Ingress / Egress

- Residences of Wilson Street and Water Street can exit the area via Robinson Street West to Hawkridge Ave
- Residences of Dublin Street, Village Squire & Sierra can exit to Robinson St through the back back parking lots after the barriers have been lifted for the event by permission of Whyte Fitness & City.
- Residences of Bruce Thompson Crt can exit via Main Street North south to Hwy 7
- Residences North of Mains Mansion and funeral home can exit via Main Street north to Bullock Dr.

Terms & Conditions for the overnight closure:

- Event Organizer(s), volunteers and/or members will provide one lane way from Dixon Garland Funeral Home on Markham Rd to Bullock Drive. Event Organizer(s) will provide volunteers to man the barricade(s) on Bullock Drive / Parkway Avenue to allow the Funeral Home Patrons egress and ingress.
- 2. Noise Exemption must end at 2300h.
- 3. York Regional Police Officer(s) must staff the <u>intersection of Hwy 7 and Markham Rd</u> at <u>all times</u> during the event road closure; Cost will be incurred by the event organizer(s).
- 4. Event organizer(s) must provide a minimum of two adults at least 18 years of age for each barricade location(s) at all times. One adult must maintain all local barricades on Friday at midnight until the following day Saturday 10:00 am.
- 5. Minimum two security guards must be provided at the expense of the organizer(s) on Saturday from midnight to 0800h to monitor Markham Road.
- 6. Event Organizer(s) must ensure emergency access is maintained at <u>all times</u>. It is imperative that emergency traffic is allowed through streets and roadways.


