



BY-LAW 2016-44

A by-law to repeal Carbon Monoxide Detectors By-law 30-1999

Whereas Pursuant to the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997 and Ontario Fire Code Section 2.16, the requirements governing the installation and maintenance of Carbon Monoxide Detectors are now mandated, as of October 15, 2015, in Provincial legislation and are enforced by members of Markham Fire & Emergency Services who are designated as Assistants to the Fire Marshal; and,

Whereas by By-law No. 30-1999, "Being a by-law to require and regulate the installation and maintenance of Carbon Monoxide Detectors in residential dwelling units" is not longer necessary; and,

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham cannot enforce or enact a By-law that supersedes the requirements of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997 and the Ontario Fire Code; and,

Whereas the information contained in By-law No. 30-1999 is inapplicable and void;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Markham hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 30-1999 be repealed in its entirety.

Read a first, second, and third time and passed on April 19, 2016.
